You'll be able to spot animals and petroglyphs better if you...

- Find the subject with unaided eyes.
- Bring binoculars just under your eyes.
- Sight the subject over the tops of the eyepieces.
- Slowly bring the binoculars up to your eyes.

- Bring plenty of water no matter the temperture.
- Wear sunglasses and a hat in warm weather.
- Wear sturdy footwear, preferably some with ankle support (hiking boots recommended).
- Always stay with your tour guide!




